In the following pages an attempt is made to describe, in convenient form, the species found in Eastern North America, and the higher groups to which they belong. The nomenclature and classification used are the same as that adopted by Prof. E. D. Cope in his Check List of North American Batrachia and Reptilia. (Bull. of U. S. Nat. Mus., No. 1.) In order to facilitate the identification of specimens, and in order that the catalogue may be available to the greatest number, when easily recognizable characters did not exist in the natural synopses, they were added in artificial ones. The works of the following authors have been especially useful in preparing the present paper: E. D. Cope, Baird, Girard, Agassiz, Holbrooks, Huxley, Dumeril, Bibron, Gray s...
