With rich qualitative data gathered from course observations, interviews, and correspondence, Restaino traces four graduate students first experiences as teachers at a large, public university. Yet the circumstances and situations she relates will ring familiar at widely varying institutions. "First Semester: Graduate Students, Teaching Writing, and the Challenge of Middle Ground " presents a fresh and challenging theoretical approach to understanding and improving the preparation of graduate students for the writing classroom. Restaino uses a three-part theoretical construct labor, action, and work, as defined in Hannah Arendt s work of political philosophy, "The Human Condition " as a lens for reading graduate students struggles to balance their new responsibilities as teachers with their concurrent roles as students. Arendt s concepts serve as access points for analysis, raising important questions about graduate student writing teachers first classrooms and uncovering opportunities for improved support...
